What is an independent school?

Independent schools (also commonly known as private schools) are not funded by the government and therefore charge school fees, though many also offer bursaries (fee reductions). They are 'independent' because of their freedom to operate outside government and local government control. Being independent means that private schools are free from government control in areas such as admissions, curriculum and assessment, although safeguarding and child protection requirements still apply.

Fee assistance and independent schools

The Independent Schools Council (ISC) (www.isc.co.uk) has over 1,300 independent school members. Over a third of the pupils attending an ISC school are on reduced school fees as a result of a school bursary or scholarship. If you are interested in finding out about ISC schools with a sixth form who offer scholarships and/or bursaries in Cardiff then you can find them listed below along with information about the school and the fee assistance that they offer.

For day students, Cardiff Sixth Form college offers scholarship awards of up to 100% of the cost of tuition fees only, for students who can demonstrate that they meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 16-18 years-old
- 8A* in GCSE or equivalent examinations
- College entrance tests (paper-based)
- Online entrance tests
- College interview

For international students, Cardiff Sixth Form College offers scholarship awards of up to 50% of the cost of tuition fees only, for students who can demonstrate that they meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 16-18 years-old
- 8A*/A+ in IGCSE or equivalent examinations
- Score of 6.5+ in Academic International English Language Test System (IELTS)
- College entrance tests (paper-based)
- Online entrance tests
- Skype interview

Application process

1. Complete the application forms and email the scanned versions to admissions@ccoex.com, along with a copy of your passport and the most recent school report. You need to complete the regular [College Application Form](#), and the [Scholarship Application Form](#).
2. Pay the registration fee and send us the payment transcript. Bank details can be found on the application form.
3. Sit an online reasoning test.

4. Sit admissions tests and have an interview with the College representative. This is arranged at a date and time convenient to you and can be conducted in person or via SKYPE. SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Up to 100% scholarships available for day students.
2. The maximum award given to overseas applicants is 50% - covering tuition fees only. In rare circumstances, a higher award can be made but this is considered on an individual basis.
3. To be considered for a scholarship, day students must obtain a minimum of 8 A* grades at GCSE (full courses) and be successful in an interview at the college.
4. To be considered for 100% scholarship, day students must achieve straight A*s in all of their full course GCSE subjects.
5. All exams must be sat in one sitting, regardless of the value of the scholarship.
6. Overseas applicants will be judged individually, for up to 50% tuition fee scholarship, based on their national examination qualifications and their performance in entrance tests.
7. Students are welcome to submit a portfolio of achievements for consideration.
8. All awards relate to tuition fees only. The applicant is required to cover all boarding costs.
9. Scholarship application will only be considered during the initial application process, before the offer has been made. We will not consider a scholarship application after this point.
10. Factors such as school background will be taken into consideration. We will take account of whether a student from an independent school currently holds a scholarship award, but evidence will need to be provided.
11. All awards are made at the discretion of the trustees, whose decision is considered to be final.
12. Students must demonstrate a strong work ethic and commitment to their studies.
13. Cardiff Sixth Form College reserves the right to withdraw an award at any time if a student demonstrates lack of commitment.
14. Awards are only given for courses lasting a minimum of two years.
15. In the event that no candidates of sufficient merit being recognised, awards will not be made.
16. The range of subjects the student has studied will be taken into account.
17. The awarding of scholarships would be dependent on the choices of subjects at A-Level.
18. UK students: if the value of a scholarship is 50% or more, the acceptance deposit reverts to an acceptance fee and is therefore non-refundable.
19. By accepting a scholarship award, the student accepts the terms and conditions of the scholarship contract.
20. In exceptional circumstances, an award can be considered for a student who suffers sudden adverse family circumstances.
