What is an independent school?

Independent schools (also commonly known as private schools) are not funded by the government and therefore charge school fees, though many also offer bursaries (fee reductions). They are 'independent' because of their freedom to operate outside government and local government control. Being independent means that private schools are free from government control in areas such as admissions, curriculum and assessment, although safeguarding and child protection requirements still apply.

Fee assistance and independent schools

The Independent Schools Council (ISC) (www.isc.co.uk) has over 1,300 independent school members. Over a third of the pupils attending an ISC school are on reduced school fees as a result of a school bursary or scholarship. If you are interested in finding out about ISC schools with a sixth form who offer scholarships and/or bursaries in Gloucester then you can find them listed below along with information about the school and the fee assistance that they offer.

CLC offers an exciting and enriching Scholarship Programme with a wealth of opportunities aimed at stretching and developing individual talent for the benefit of the whole community. Being a Scholar is a position of honour at CLC and those who earn the title will play a key role in the life of the school and enjoy the chance to lead and inspire others whilst fulfilling their own potential. Scholarship Awards do not carry fee remission but families can apply for assistance with fees (from 1%-100%, depending on circumstances) through our Beale Award scheme.

Scholarships are awarded at the following points of entry:

11+: Academic, Music

13+: Academic, Music, Art, Sport

Sixth Form: Academic, Music, Art, Sport

Bursary Information

Our means-tested bursaries are known as Beale Awards, named after our second Principal, Dorothea Beale, who was a pioneer in the education of young women. These awards offer free or partially-funded places to talented girls seeking either boarding or day places. We are committed to educating those whom we believe are likely to flourish here, regardless of their means and these awards take into account both the financial circumstances of an applicant's family and her performance in written entrance tests and interviews.

It is essential that families who wish to explore financial support options contact the Admissions Department (admissions@cheltladiescollege.org) well in advance of the proposed date of admission.

This will enable the greatest chance of being considered for the funds available. Applications for Beale Awards made after the published deadline will not be considered. Beale Awards will only be available to girls when we can guarantee that the fee-paying parent(s) are resident in the UK for tax purposes.

Bursary support with school fees:

Cheltenham College is committed to providing mean-tested financial assistance to both new and existing pupils.

All bursary awards are subject to a bursary application. They are based on careful and sympathetic scrutiny of individual family circumstances and no generalisation of appropriate income levels is possible. A child must be registered before a bursary can be applied for and we strongly recommend early application as there is only a limited amount of funds available and not all requests for support will be able to be met.

We encourage parents to make bursary applications no later than the end of Autumn Term prior to entry in order to allow time for careful and proper consideration of each family's needs. In any event, applications must be received no later than seven months prior to starting at College, ordinarily by the end of January for the following September start of term.

Values of bursary awards vary greatly and in very rare circumstances, they can reach up to 100% of the fees (usually in conjunction with a scholarship). Scholarships

Excellence is encouraged in both academic and co-curricular aspects of College life. One of the main vehicles for such encouragement is the offer of College Awards in the form of Scholarships and Exhibitions, awarded at 13+ or 16+. College Awards include Academic, Art, Drama, Music and Sport. Scholarships are awarded for outstanding performance and ability in a chosen field and Exhibitions for excellent talent and potential.

College has high expectations of Award holders and they are expected to have an encouraging attitude for learning and collaboration in their chosen field and throughout all of their classes at College. In addition to exhibiting excellence and flair in their field of expertise, they are expected to utilise opportunities to develop and take on leadership positions.

A Scholarship is valued at up to 15% of the fees and an Exhibition is valued at up to 10% of the fees, with the exception of the Lord James of Hereford (awarded to the candidate that performs best overall in the Scholarship papers for 13+) and the Prain Scholarship (rewarding a particular ability in Mathematics and Science for 13+), these are both valued at 20% of the fees. Pupils are able to apply for awards in more than one category, but the fee remission is capped, irrespective of the number or individual value of the awards held.

13+ Awards

Applicants are to complete papers and interviews to assess their suitability for the award. For more information on the appropriate processes, please do contact our Admissions Team.

Academic, Drama, Music and Sports awards are valid throughout the holder's time at College, subject to satisfactory progress, conduct and participation. Art awards are valid, initially for the three years prior to A Level, and are dependent on the subject taken at GCSE. If the award holder chooses to study Art in Sixth Form, the award will automatically continue.

16+ Awards

16+ Awards are available to both current pupils and external applicants (although current pupils will not receive any fees remission if they are awarded a 16+ award).

The papers are designed to test potential and are broadly based on Key Stage 4/GCSE. They do not however test the knowledge of a particular syllabus, followed by an interview with the Head of Department. For more information on the appropriate processes, please do contact our Admissions Team.

At St Edward's there are a range of scholarships available for pupils entering the School in Year 7 and Lower Sixth.

Pupils who gain scholarships have access to our Scholarship Programme designed to develop them further. We have the highest expectations of them; they will have opportunities to be challenged and inspire others through their contribution to the life of the School.

The Trustees are also committed to broadening access to the School and a limited number of bursaries are offered each year to pupils who would benefit from an education at St Edward's. Bursary holders are expected to make a significant contribution to the life of the School. Bursaries are available up to a maximum of 100% and are all means tested. Applicants are subject to an assessment of income and outgoings, assets and liabilities. The level of support given will reflect the individual circumstances of the family.
